**Summary of talk:** Photo activist projects can raise public awareness of an issue through images and can be a powerful way to resist dominant ideologies that marginalize oppressed communities. Matacin will discuss her use of photo projects as a pedagogical tool to engage and empower students to address social inequities (e.g., racial microaggressions, gender injustices, ableism). Some scholars argue that social change can only occur with the inclusion of communities directly affected. Thus, she will also discuss photovoice, a participatory research methodology with roots in critical pedagogy, feminist theory, and documentary photography.

**Short biography:** Mala Matacin is an Associate Professor of Psychology at the University of Hartford (West Hartford, CT, USA). She received her Ph.D. in Social Psychology (University of Cincinnati) and completed a post-doctoral fellowship in Preventive and Behavioral Medicine (Brown University School of Medicine). Her commitment to interdisciplinary and social justice work has led her to create several courses that examine structural inequities based on a variety of social identities (e.g., gender, sexuality, class, race, ability, body size, religion); she has received several University teaching awards. She is currently on her academic sabbatical here in Croatia where she is working on creating a short-term study abroad program and forming research partnerships.
